A Gallery of glorious Gardens

Grouping #1

- 1 The entrance circle of the **Asian Walk** is flanked by Foo dogs followed by the dragon of the Great Wall and a Terra Cotta Warrior.
 - 2 Step into an **Orchard** of peach, pear, persimmon, nectarine, and fig trees.
 - 3 The **Magnolia Allee** is composed of native Magnolia virginiana.
 - 4 **Conifer Hill** is the home of Cupressus funebris and Juniperus deppeana 'McFetter'.
- A Alice in Wonderland statues are scattered in the woods of **Liviana's Wonderland**.

Grouping #2

- B Charlotte's Garden** creates a serene atmosphere, reflecting on poetry.
- C El Jardin magnifico de Mickie** showcases an abundance of daylilies.
- 1 Don't miss the **Moon Garden** lawns with magnolias and hollies.
 - 2 Take the path to the **Koi Pond** alive with Koi fish and hardy water lilies.
- D** Pause to admire the Lion head fountain in **Will's Garden**, the first garden which was started in 2000.

Grouping #3

- 1 A delightful **Charleston Garden** shows the influence of European landscape design with a formal, geometric design of boxwood, roses, and palm trees.
 - 2 Observe the old-world charm in the **Victorian Rose Garden**.
 - 4 Matsuri towers over the **Asian Fountain** which displays color-changing fountain lights.
 - 5 Experience a tranquil stroll through the **Japanese Garden**, over an entrance bridge, to view stone lanterns, waterfalls, and a tea house.
- E Desiree's Jardin** adds a tropical touch with palm trees, banana plants, parrots, and a sloth.
- 6 Michie Trail** is a path honoring the Michie family.
- F** Relax and enjoy the views. Gandolf is standing guard to keep the bears and raccoons at bay in **Malachi's Retreat**.

Grouping #4

- G** A Nevermore Raven statue in **Ian's Woods** leads to a shady path through the pines.
- 1 On the steep slope of **The Rock Garden** are varieties of xeriscape plants.
 - 2 At the **Terraces of Vera Mae**, Dr. Who welcomes guests to the Once Upon a Time moon statue.
- H** Fairies welcome guests to **Indigo Lake's Garden**, with a cat and mouse birdbath in a woodland setting.
- I** A habitat for birds and wildlife, **Wyatt's Wilderness** is guarded by Iolanthe, Fiona, Eryl, and gargoyles.
- 5 The famous rose 'Peggy Martin', a survivor of hurricane Katrina, is the centerpiece of **The River Rose Garden**.
 - 6 Access to the **Noah & Willa Mae Remembrance Garden** is gained by way of a decorative entrance gate that opens onto a path of the 'Old South'.

- K** A creative thatched roof Tiki Hut in **Weir Valley** encloses the 'Spirit of Success' sculpture by Zimbabwe's artist, Willard Bopoto.
